Chernoff Ventilation Shutdown Notice!

Pre Shutdown - Prior to July 27th 4:00 pm

All identified fume hoods will be closed and de-activated by 2:00 pm on July 27th

Inspections of all labs will take place 2:00 pm—4:00pm on July 27th

ACTION ITEMS:

- ✓ All chemicals need to be capped throughout the entire lab; in the fume hoods, vented cabinets, throughout the general lab spaces, etc.
- ✓ Vacuum systems (Mass spec, ICP, SEM) should no longer be “under load”

1st Shutdown - Friday July 28th 1:00 pm to Monday July 31st 1:00 pm

All supply and return air will be shut down in the research wing, teaching labs and 1st floor room #'s CHE100-114

Research wing will be off limits for the duration of the shutdown



After Shutdown - July 31st to August 11th

Undergraduate labs to remain closed and isolated

50% reduction to remaining fume hood availability

ACTION ITEMS:

- ✓ Reduce the load on pumps and solvent cabinet storage to 50%

Pre Shutdown - Prior to August 10th 4:00 pm

Inspections of all labs will take place 2:00 pm—4:00pm on August 10th

- ✓ All chemicals need to be capped throughout the entire lab; in the fume hoods, vented cabinets, throughout the general lab spaces, etc.
- ✓ Vacuum systems (Mass spec, ICP, SEM) should no longer be “under load”

2nd Shutdown - Friday August 11th 1:00 pm to Monday August 14th 7:00 am

All supply and return air will be shut down in the research wing, teaching labs and 1st floor room #'s CHE100-114

Research wing will be off limits for the duration of the shutdown
