


# Chemically-Contaminated SHARPS WASTE

- Needles
- Razor blades
- Knives
- Syringes (glass & plastic barrels and plungers)



## NOT ALLOWED:


- Biological contaminants

# Biologically-Contaminated SHARPS WASTE



## ALLOWED:

- Needles
- Razor blades
- Knives
- Syringes (glass & plastic barrels and plungers)



# GLASS WASTE



## ALLOWED:

- Vials (empty)
- Broken glass
- Alcohol thermometers
- Glass syringe barrels & plungers



## NOT ALLOWED:

- Disposable pipettes
- Mercury thermometers
- Vials/bottles containing chemicals
- Barcoded chemical containers
- Needles

# SYRINGE BARREL & PLUNGER WASTE



## ALLOWED:

- Plastic syringe barrels
- Plastic syringe plungers



## NOT ALLOWED:

- Glass syringes
- Needles
- Anything else

# GARBAGE



## ALLOWED:

- Wood
- Paper
- Plastics
- Other non-hazardous materials



## NOT ALLOWED:

- Chemicals, powders, sharps, glass, syringes, chemical bottles, etc.
- Food or drink containers
- Anything contaminated with hazardous chemicals (e.g. gloves)

# SOLID WASTE

(List all known components)



## ALLOWED:

- Silica gel
- Drying agents (mol sieves,  $\text{MgSO}_4$ , etc.)
- Contaminated gloves
- Contaminated paper towels



# FLAMMABLE LIQUID WASTE



## ALLOWED:

- Solvents (even if not flammable)
- Halogenated solvents
- Combustible organics
